SCARECROW SPECIFICATIONS

- Complete and return this registration form to Retzer Nature Center by Wednesday, September 15.
- Pick up your scarecrow assembly packet from Retzer Nature Center with all the necessary information to build your scarecrow. Included in this packet is an orange tag to display your scarecrow's name, the names of your group members, and the specific category you are entering your scarecrow.

SCARECROW DELIVERY INFORMATION

- Bring your completed scarecrow to Retzer Nature Center.
- Delivery and setup days are:
Wednesday and Thursday, September 15 & 16 from 8:00 AM to dusk.
Friday, September 17 from 8:00 AM to Noon.
- You will place your own scarecrow on stakes provided on the paved "Adventure Trail."
- Bring your own wire, tape, string and tools (pliers, scissors, etc.) to attach your scarecrow to the stakes.

JUDGING

- Judging will be done on Friday afternoon, September 17.

AWARDS

- All scarecrows will be awarded a Participation Ribbon.
- First, Second, and Third Place Ribbons will be awarded in each category.
- A "Best of Festival 2010" ribbon will be awarded from all categories.
- Ribbons will be displayed on the winning Scarecrows after Friday's judging and seen by all attending the Retzer Apple Harvest Festival.

AFTER THE FESTIVAL

- You will be responsible for removing your scarecrow one week after the Apple Harvest Festival. We would like to allow visitors coming to the nature center the opportunity to see your creative scarecrows.
- Scarecrows can be removed starting Wed., September 29 thru Friday, October 1.
- Scarecrows remaining after October 1 will be donated for display at the Waukesha County Park's Halloween Event, *Spooka Minooka*, held at Minooka Park on Friday, October 22.
